## ■ *Who is the Michigan Primary Care Association?*

Since 1980, Michigan Primary Care Association (MPCA) has been the voice for Community Health Centers (CHCs) and other community-based providers in Michigan. Today, 32 CHCs provide quality, comprehensive, community-oriented primary health care for nearly 500,000 patients annually at 160 sites across Michigan. Of those 32 CHCs, 29 are Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and 3 are FQHC 'Look-Alikes.' In addition to representing all 32 Michigan CHCs, MPCA also represents three community-based providers and six associate members. Turn the page for a list of the organizations.

Michigan Primary Care Association is a leader in building a healthy society in which all residents have convenient and affordable access to quality health care.
